It is with a heart full of gratitude that we (Gianni Diurni Primary school) address this letter to you and all your audience to thank you for all that you are doing for our African mission especially for the schools and the orphanage.

The support we receive from you changed the life of our School community (EP Gianni Diurni) because it generates joy, love and hope in the life of all children in our schools and the orphanage as well.

We express our gratitude, and we thank you in a special way for the “big and particular donations” that we receive for the feeding of the children of EP Gianni Diurni School. In fact, prior to your donation, the direction of the school together with the team of the teachers realized that most of the children were sleeping during classes, especially the last hours of the day. This was not because they had to sleep, but obviously because they were going hungry (starving). The situation in the region is not good and all the roads that supply food are under rebel’s blockage and many people are displaced. We couldn’t do anything to help the children apart from welcoming them to our schools... Indeed, most of them are from the families who flee for their lives, left behind their villages and all their belongings because of war. Goma Town is full of displaced people; the cost of living went high and up to today nothing has changed in Goma and around Goma (there are many refugees camps built to host the displaced people).

However, through your care and the support that we receive from you, the situation at school changed during break time, all the children receive something to eat. Your loving and generous gestures generated joys, love and hope in the life of the children and their parents are so much grateful. We thank you for helping us to have a peaceful and good school year. This year was so special because we taught and fed the children here at Gianni Diurni Primary School. The donations you gave were well received and the effects can be felt that “we don’t have the appropriate word to describe the joys and hopes they brought in our school-life”. Children started to have a good time, energy and more committed and willing to learn than before. None of them went hungry but were always happy to come to school... They all felt loved!

Dear Barbara, these children learnt many things through your generous and caring heart. May you be blessed in all your endeavors. We know your love for our missions, and everyone can testify to it. The love and care you have for our schools and orphanage are vivid and felt. We are sure that all these children who study in our schools are learning more not only intellectual skills but

Christian virtues for they survive because of you and all our benefactors. Thank you for" serving the poorest of the poor"!





